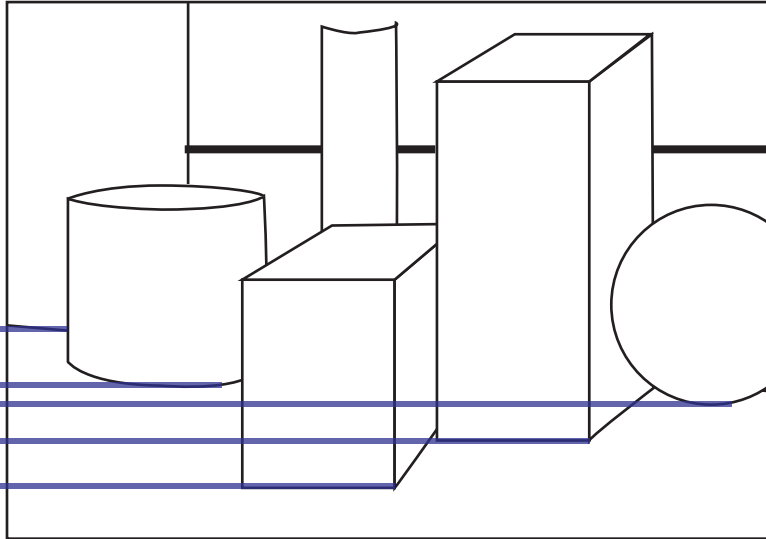


# Still Life Composition Arrangements

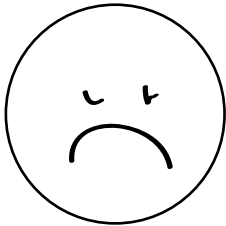
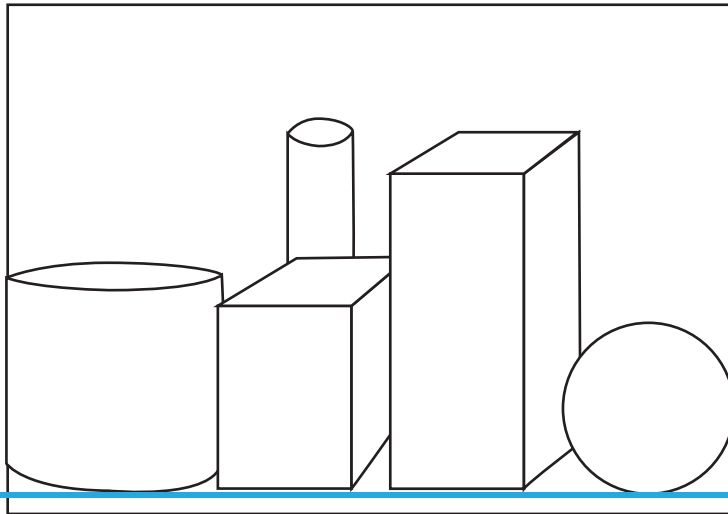
Bottom of all objects start at different baselines

Object is cut off = gives sense that drawing can expand beyond edges



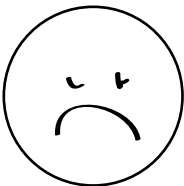
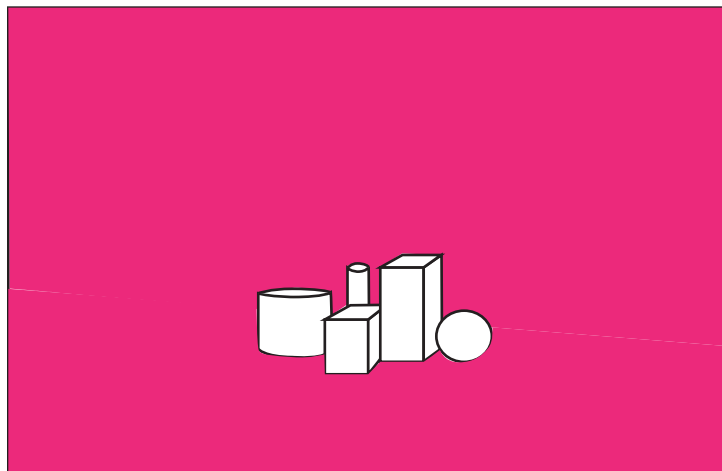
Shapes fill page = more detail and value are visible  
Shapes are drawn up from bottom of page;  
**horizon line** is drawn towards top of the page and is visible

Shapes are too low on page = no room for shadows on surface;  
can't determine horizon line. Bottom of all shapes start at same baseline

Shapes are too small for overall composition = large amounts of **negative space** = objects get lost in background;  
hard to see detail (shadow, shapes)
